Hello, Licensees!

We are excited to announce that the Alabama Board of Physical Therapy is upgrading its regulatory software! Our new provider, Thentia, will offer a more user-friendly experience for you!

-What does this mean for you, the average licensee?

For most licensees, you won't notice any changes right away. However, during the next renewal season, you will need to create a new account through the Thentia portal. Don't worry — we'll provide clear, step-by-step instructions well in advance.

However, we do encourage you to go ahead and set up your Thentia portal profile *after* Thentia is live. There you will be able to access a copy of your license, update your work or personal information, etc. We think you'll find the Thentia portal to be a valuable resource for you and as a bonus, you'll already have your login credentials when it is time to renew!

-Temporary "Black-Out" Period

We will have a "black-out" period of beginning November 8, 2025, through December 1, 2025, during which certain online functions will be unavailable, including, but not limited to:

- Online Applications
- Online User Profiles

We expect that the Licensee Lookup and License Verification features will remain available. If you experience any difficulty—or if you need a verification sent to another state or entity—we will have a temporary form available for you to complete and email to us.

-Who Will Be Most Affected Immediately by this Change?

- New applicants
- Expired renewal applicants

During this period, we will provide paper applications that can be accessed through our website – www.pt.alabama.com - printed, completed, and mailed to the Board office along with the appropriate fees (cashier's check or money order) and any required documentation. The Board's mailing address is:
